Notable Facts:

- 1) multi-color socks originated when club started wearing red socks(1985) instead of black. By end of season most players did not still have two red socks due primarily to funding issues, so all available socks (Red & Black) were pooled and distributed so everyone matched. It was decided that Red on Right, Black on Left. Maroon now is worn in place of the former Club Color if Red, was replaced by Maroon (school color) in 2005. Red remains in the Club Shield/Crest;
- 2) Grey is the primary club color because the first set of jerseys purchased in 1984, were the only color available the Club could afford as a discounted set. The color grey remains as a tribute to clubs' humble history/roots;
- 3) San Marcos Greys men's Senior Club established in 2012 by Alumni if TXST and frequently train with TXST;
- 4) Formed by Alan Noel & Phil McKnown, both from Midland, TX. Alan Noel attended and played at Duke University before coming to TXST (then Southwest Texas State) in 1983.
- 5) San Marcos sits between Austin & San Antonio, TX and has a population of approx 54,000;
- 6) San Marcos River originates from and underground spring on campus and flows through the center of town. Archeologists have determined that it is the oldest continuously inhabited location in North America;
- 7) TXST has an enrollment of approx 38,000 students and is the third most applied to Univesrity in Texas, behind Texas & Tx A&M.
